The Clubs Consortium was formed by Pauline Lee in approximately 2021 in Clark County. The goals of the Consortium are threefold: 1) to share best practices in leadership skills and leadership tips for our Conservative Organizations, 2) to create and foster collaborations among the groups to accomplish various goals; and 3) to increase productivity within our groups. The Consortium meets once a month, and in August, Sue Zarubin, MRW 2nd VP, represented MRW at the meeting. This is her report:

I recently had the privilege of attending a Consortium meeting consisting of several conservative groups with John Burke as the presenter. John is head of the Better Nevada PAC and works directly with Governor Lombardo and others. He shared about the importance of using Social Media as a great tool to get the vote out and change minds of Independents.

It has been found that Twitter (now X) is the most effective means to communicate conservative information to the general population. Instagram is second, with Facebook being good but more Republicans use Facebook then Democrats, so you are kind of preaching to the choir on FB.

Some general rules to consider for the greatest time/affect includes:

- Choose your battles carefully. There are so many opinions out there, you could spend hours that you really don't have. It is very easy to get pulled into arguing but will it really cause change? Reality is, those who are extremists will never listen to you... so keep your efforts focused.
- Work together. Join groups that speak to you or build one yourself. I have some personal favorites that are factual and intelligent in their approach. I not only learn but I help spread the work by retweeting those things I think might reach others and help.
- Stick to the facts. Don't get caught up in emotions, but be accurate in what you post. Think if someone could use misinformation against you and your desire to spread the truth? At times you really do need to do research. I also find it helpful to site my sources at times.
- Stay timely. Comment on things people are thinking about.
- Our goal is to influence those who are on the fence. Be intelligent in your postings.




