A Message from our President ...

Dear Members and Friends,

Greetings! I hope this finds you doing well as we experience our incredible Mesquite weather!

As you all know, the Presidential Preference Poll and the Caucus are behind us- as predicted, President Donald Trump won with a huge lead. I want to thank the many members of MRW who volunteered their time and efforts working as poll watchers, poll workers, caucus workers and signature collectors for the Voter ID petition taken at the caucus. I am so proud that we are so visible in our community, and that we continue to oversee election integrity to the best of our ability. Interestingly, there were some problems with the Secretary of State's website and the PPP election- you will find a short article with a link to this issue in this newsletter. I would love to hear what you think after reading this article.

We are in the final stage of choosing our campaign office. We have three options. I believe the best one is at the Brickyard, suite C40, where the TaeKwon-Do office was. It is double the space we had in 2022, so the rent is also double, however we would have the space to do many activities at our office. The second best option is a newly refinished space (about the same as 2022) but parking is not the best and visibility is a challenge- it is on the other side of the street between Clark County Printing and the Laundromat (has car sales in front). The last option is also in Brickyard, suite C60, about the same size as 2022, but the room is divided. If we were to lease the large office space in Brickyard, we would need several people to make a commitment to donate monthly, as we would be about \$1000 per month for 7 months short in our projected budget... So I am reaching out to you, as a group, for your input and if you are able to commit to donation? Please send me your thoughts ASAP as we need to secure our office space.

Annie, first VP over events, has created a wonderful agenda of activities for the rest of the year. Our first goal is to get more patriotic Republicans elected on every level. Another of our goals is to foster relationship building amongst our membership as well as to grow our numbers, so as soon as we open our campaign office, we will start having social events in addition to our regular meetings. More on that soon.

Our Spring Festival promises to be an active and fun filled event for our community. Melissa Hunt is heading this up again for the third year in a row. Please read the article and consider helping us!

Your membership in MRW includes membership and access to the Nevada Federation of Republican Women as well as National Federation of Republican Women. I am adding a flyer for the Spring Board Meeting of the Nevada FRW in this newsletter in case you would enjoy attending this with me in April. Everyone is welcome and this is a great opportunity to learn more about the state level activity.

TRUMP: INNOCENT!

The assault on President Trump from the left continues. They throw mud hoping that something, nay, anything will stick. The ridiculous sham in New York by Letitia James most recently shows how they are trying to weaponize the rule of law. Perhaps they should read what the law says.

On February 8th, the Supreme Court announced that they would render a decision on Trump v Anderson (the Colorado case) by February 16th, but it was crickets. Mark Levin reminds all of us that the Declaration of Independence recognizes "a circle of liberty "around every single individual that is not to be molested, or penetrated by the government. The U.S. Constitution puts great limits on the central government through the Bill of Rights and enumerated powers to protect the individual.1

Straight out of the Declaration of Independence:

"We hold these truths to be self-evident that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty, and the pursuit of Happiness."2

The pursuit of happiness includes one's profession, to go about, and to practice. Not only did Donald Trump build the New York City skyline but he made hundreds of millions for himself and the corporation he built, but also all those that got on board the Trump train.

It appears the Democrats absolutely despise and hate President Trump for being a successful entrepreneur, so much so that Letitia James ran on a campaign to go after and prosecute him for his efforts. Perhaps they don't understand unintended consequences. Welcome to the brave new world, Latitia. You are just another partisan hack.

Before someone is charged with a crime, there needs to be a crime. Leticia chose fraud, but Trump did business like anyone else in the real estate industry. Perhaps you haven't noticed, but there is going to be a huge exodus as businesses flee New York! Perhaps a finger on the pulse of the industry will clue you in....

Yahoo Finance quoted Grant Cardone the other day in a post on X:

"Dear Cardone Capital team, immediately discontinue ALL underwriting on New York City real estate. The risk outweighs the opportunities at this time. Recent political decisions will continue to deteriorate price and benefit states that don't have these challenges. Focus on Texas & Florida.".3

He argued that it's the bank's responsibility to see through developers' exaggerated financial claims, and that Trump's actions are normal.

"That haggling has gone on for decades" he continued. "That's how it works.4

The case was initiated strictly by efforts to weaponize the legal system by a Democrat District Attorney and a Judge who fail to understand their oath to the Constitution. The whole sham is to waste President Trump's time and money and to keep him off the campaign trail. America is tired of it, and soon the Supreme Court will be too.

Fortunately, far greater learned legal minds have considered the dangers of when "the system" is weaponized and used to silence citizens.

In the Bill of Rights in our Constitution, we find the 8th Amendment:

Excessive bail shall not be required, nor excessive fines imposed, nor cruel and unusual punishments inflicted.

In 2019, the Supreme Court Case of Timbs v Indiana, the court's opinion was very clear:

Holding: The Eighth Amendment's excessive fines clause is an incorporated protection applicable to the states under the 14th Amendment's due process clause.

Judgment: Vacated and remanded, 9-0, in an opinion by Justice Ginsburg on February 20, 2019. Justice Gorsuch filed a concurring opinion. Justice Thomas filed an opinion concurring in the judgment.5

Ruth Bader Ginsburg summarized it quite well:

"The Excessive Fines Clause traces its venerable lineage back to at least 1215," wrote Ginsburg, "Magna Carta required that economic sanctions 'be proportioned to the wrong' and 'not be so large as to deprive [an offender] of his livelihood." 6

Not that the president did anything wrong, there were just more efforts to create impossible barriers for him. Even if it were about the money, then why did the man choose NOT to take a salary as president? As President Trump said so eloquently a few weeks ago: "My retribution will be my success;" and recently on The Ingraham Angle, he said "My revenge will be my success".

Voter ID Petition Drive – Let's Make It Happen!

Many of you will remember the Voter Id Initiative Petition that was attempted in 2022 but was struck down in the courts. The creator of that initiative, Dave Gibbs, and his group, Repair the Vote, has a new Voter Id Petition that was approved by the Court on February 26. (The Democrats challenge all such filings in court.) The initiative proposes an amendment to the Nevada Constitution such that "each voter in Nevada shall present photo identification to verify their identity when voting in person". Additionally, "each voter in Nevada who votes by mail-in ballot shall enter one of the following ...to use in verifying the voter's identity...". 140,000 signatures are needed on the petitions by June to get the initiative on the ballot in November. It must pass in 2024 and again in 2026 to become part of the Constitution.

Dave has been joined by NevadansCan, Sun City Summerlin (CSC) Conservatives, Turning Point Action, and NvFRW Clubs across Nevada in this signature drive. MRW is doing its part here in Mesquite by sponsoring training in the signature gathering process and organizing by precincts to contact registered Republicans and Non-Partisans. We have access to a training video, petition packets, and precinct walk lists and maps provided by the sponsors from Clark County voting records. A side benefit of this activity is to build a database for candidate appeals and Get-Out-the-Vote efforts in November.

We hope everyone will sign the petition AND spread the word to neighbors and family and get them to sign. The petition will be available at MRW meetings and in our Election Office when it opens in April. Additionally, you can contact me to sign (swtinsd@gmail.com, 858-254-1214).

Many thanks to the 10 volunteers who met with me on February 23 to take the training, get their signature packets, and are gathering signatures right now! We hope many of YOU will volunteer to take the training (one hour) and become part of the group getting signatures in your precinct. Please contact me to take the training and be put in contact with your precinct committee. The rules for the signatures are quite strict, and before you spend your time and effort, we want you to have the training. If we don't follow the rules exactly, the whole sheet of signatures will be thrown out by the Court in June. Members are also organizing to set up petition signing tables around town. PLEASE let us know if you want to be a part of this effort. Every little bit will help, and it is all greatly appreciated!


