

It is common knowledge that the country is split on many issues right now, but I think most people can agree on an important one: we all want fair elections.

One solution to alleviate the questioning of our election results which is generally agreed upon by all sides, is to have a fair voter ID requirement in order to cast a ballot in Nevada. A proposed ballot measure has been written and approved by the courts to be considered. If enough registered voters in Nevada sign this petition by June 26, it can be placed on the November ballot for the People to decide on this issue.

You can read the text of the Petition on the website mesquitenvrepublicanwomen.org. Upon reading the Petition, you will note there are a wide variety of acceptable ID's (at least one is required to actually register to vote). You can also find the Petition on RepairTheVote.us. To me, this is a common sense solution.

Each one of us has the opportunity to sign this Petition in various locations in Mesquite as well as at the upcoming Clark County Fair (April 10 – 14). A registered voter from any party is welcome to sign; this really isn't a partisan issue and all are welcome. You can often find a table in front of the library, at the Rec Center, at Ace Hardware, or at the Republican Election Office when it opens in the Brickyard Shopping Center in April. MRW is staffing all these locations to get signatures and we need YOUR help! Contact us at swtinsd@gmail.com or 858-254-1214. We will give you the required training, the forms and badges, and put you on the schedule!

I hope you agree that this makes sense, a practical way to eliminate controversy, and you will choose to sign it! I did!

Spring Festival Update

We are very excited about our plans for the Spring Festival. Rick Wall and the Outlaws band will provide us entertainment all day. That will be such a fun atmosphere! We also currently have 39 vendors, to food trucks, the bake sale and the silent auction and 50/50 raffle. Remember, this is our main fundraiser for the year, so we need it to be successful!

These are the areas of need:

- We need to borrow some 6 foot tables, a few folding chairs and pop up style tents.
- A crew to come to the park at 8am and help set up our tables for membership, petitions, voter registration, the silent auction and the bake sale. We will also need to set up several pop up covers. This is a great opportunity for our associates to be involved. This normally only takes about an hour to accomplish.
- A crew to come to the park at 4pm to help take everything down and back to storage or the Election Office. This typically only takes about an hour.
- We will need many, many of you to donate baked goods to be sold. This includes cookies, muffins, breads (mini loaf or regular loaf), pie, and treats that are easy to eat and won't melt in the sun. An item that would be exceptional for us to add is sugar-free or gluten free items. All baked good must be delivered to Priss Steelman on Friday, April 19th so her crew can package them for sale. If you need help getting your goods to her, let us know and someone will deliver for you.
- We will need 2 or 3 volunteers per shift to help sell the baked goods on April 20th. Priss has set 3 hour shifts so no one has to be on duty too long. Everything will be packaged and priced, so it is fun to visit with people and sell them goodies
